

Costa Rica: University of Costa Rica

This program gives students an opportunity to study the Spanish language and the cultures of Latin and Central America and to take courses at the University of Costa Rica in a chosen field. Students studying biology have found interesting courses here taught in English in ecology and biodiversity.

Qualifications: Students must have completed 2 years of college-level Spanish or the equivalent as determined by Reed's Spanish Department.
